



Acceptable Use Policy (AUP) for Technology Policy

2025-26

Principal: Mr. Mohannad Al Jayousi

1. Purpose

This policy establishes guidelines for the appropriate use of all school-provided and personal technology resources to:

- Promote digital responsibility
- Ensure cybersecurity
- Protect student privacy
- Maintain academic integrity
- Comply with UAE laws and regulations

2. Scope

Applies to:

- ✓ All students, staff, parents, and visitors
- School-owned devices, networks, and software
- Personal devices connected to RAIS networks (BYOD)
- ✓ Cloud platforms (Google Workspace, Microsoft 365)

3. General Acceptable Use

Permitted Activities

- ✓ Educational research & coursework
- ✓ Teacher-assigned digital projects
- ✓ School-approved communication tools
- ✓ Responsible creative expression

Prohibited Activities

- X Accessing inappropriate content (pornography, violence, hate speech)
- **✗** Bypassing network security (VPNs, proxies, TOR)
- X Illegal downloads (pirated software/media)
- X Cyberbullying or harassment
- X Unauthorized data sharing (student records, test materials)
- X Any other violations to school policies and UAE laws and regulations

4. User Responsibilities

A. Students Must:

- Use school accounts only for educational purposes
- Keep passwords private (never share)
- Report security risks immediately (phishing, hacking attempts)
- Cite digital sources properly to avoid plagiarism

B. Staff Must:

- Monitor student device use during class
- Model positive digital citizenship
- Secure sensitive data with encryption

C. Parents Must:

- Review AUP annually with their child
- Monitor home device use
- Support school cybersecurity measures

5. Network & Data Security

Requirement	Details
Password Rules	12+ characters, changed every 90 days
Device Updates	OS/antivirus must be current
File Storage	School cloud only (no local storage of sensitive data)
Monitoring	All traffic logged and filtered

6. Social Media & Communication

Allowed

- ✓ Teacher-moderated class groups
- ✓ School-approved educational platforms

Restricted

- X Private student-teacher messaging (outside school tools)
- X Anonymous accounts impersonating others

7. Consequences for Violations

All violations will be subject to consequences in accordance with the school's behaviour policy.

8. Digital Citizenship Pledge

All users agree to:

- ♦ Respect others online
- ♦ Protect personal and school data
- ♦ Learn responsibly with technology
- ♦ Report unsafe behaviour
